

# Cascade Official Receives Industry Leadership Award

Ray Noonan Jr., president of Cascade Lumber Company, received the Structural Building Components (SBC) Industry Leadership award at the Wood Truss Council of America (WTCA) annual meeting held on October 2. The award recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions to the building component industry and is one of the highlights of the industry's annual conference and trade show.

In his acceptance Noonan stated, "I am humbled for the honor of being selected for this award by a group of my peers and I gratefully accept it in the name of my co-workers. It is they who have made it possible for me to be receiving this award."
